	The committee reviewed Policy 5756 Transgender and adopted the changes that matched the Rockaway District Policy.
	More discussion on the Passive Breath Alcohol Sensor Device was had. We were informed by our attorney that the application of the breathalyzer is not admissible in court and that we are not held to the same standard as a breathalyzer used by the police. The police are using it to identify criminal activity. We were also informed that we need to have a public hearing. Input from the community is necessary. The committee members felt that the application of the breathalyzer is not currently feasible at athletic events and if used at all should be piloted at a confined event like prom. However, trying to iron out all the details by June 9 th does not seem possible. All committee members felt there were a lot of details to attend to.

	P5516 Use of Electronic Communications & Recording Devices (ECRD) (M) (Revised); <i>(as reference see also district P2363 Pupil Use of Privately-Owned Technology)</i> was discussed. Ms. Gerrety had found a discrepancy with our BYOD policy and was revising. Changes are minimal. Strauss Esmay is not providing more guidance and told us to adapt to our own

	district. We revised the third paragraph of the policy to include our BYOD policy.				
	The committee reviewed P8500 Lunch Programs and made the following revision (highlighted) to include the fact that our seniors can leave campus for lunch. The Randolph Township Board of Education is fortunate to have suitable lunchroom facilities in each of its schools for all of its students. Hot, nutritious lunches are served in all cafeterias. All students, therefore, are required to remain in their school buildings or on the grounds thereof during the lunch period, with the exception of high school seniors who can leave campus for open lunch with the approval of high school administrators.
