CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The co-curricular program is designed to furnish all students an opportunity to develop their interests, to offer their service to the school and the community, and to widen their education through those activities which are sponsored or approved by the Board, but are not offered for credit toward graduation.

Each co-curricular activity shall be open to every student in the school in which it is offered who meets the Board eligibility standard as per Board Policy No. 232. Should it be necessary to set additional eligibility requirements for any activity, said requirements shall be presented to the Board for consideration prior to adoption.

Each request of an individual student or a group of students for school sponsorship of a proposed co-curricular activity shall be given careful consideration by the Superintendent.

Generally, such requests shall be implemented unless the activity will be too costly, the anticipated participation too low, the eligibility criteria discriminatory, or the necessary supervisory staff unavailable to administer the activity.

The Superintendent will report annually to the Board on the nature of the activities provided.
