

Education Motions – May 13, 2009 V2

1. **MOTION** to approve an overnight field trip for students of Randolph High School to travel to Europe (Spain, France, and Italy). The trip will take place from March 24 to April 3, 2010. The objective of this trip is to broaden awareness of the world and experience cultures geographically adjacent but yet unique. Total travel arrangements are estimated to cost each student \$3,743.40. One or more chaperones will be scheduled to accompany students to maintain a ratio of 1-6. Chaperone expenses are included in the students' costs.

2. **MOTION** to approve an overnight field trip for eight Randolph High School students travel to San Cristobal, Dominican Republic. Students will continue the construction of the community soup kitchen service learning project initiated by Karen Rodino in May 2008. The trip will take place from January 14 – 19, 2010 and students will be chaperoned by Karen Rodino and Bonnie Baumert. Total travel arrangements are estimated to cost each student \$850.00. The chaperones will pay for their own expenses.

3. **MOTION** to approve a field trip for Randolph Middle School on the following date. Costs for transportation and any associated fees will be paid by the students or as noted. No student will be deprived of participation due to financial hardship.

5. **MOTION** to approve submission of an application to apply for the NJ program entitled Personalized Student Learning Plan Pilot Program in the amount of \$15,000.00. This program is designed to promote a student centered learning environment per District Goal I. The program will begin on July 1, 2009 and end on June 30, 2011. Year one will involve grade six teachers and students; year 2 will involve both grades six and seven.
6. **MOTION** to approve the placement of Randolph Student **SE09-64 Grade PreK** in the Special Education program at PG Chambers School effective April 27, 2009 and, BE IT FURTHER MOVED, that a contract be entered into with PG Chambers School at the tuition rate of \$5,364.00 (pro rated).

ADDENDUM

12. **MOTION** to approve a Memorandum of Understanding between Randolph Township Schools and Fairleigh Dickinson University of New Jersey for Randolph to participate in science and math professional development opportunities via the IETSM Science and Math Grant. Fees will be covered by the IETSM grant. Randolph agrees to provide facilities for workshops held on site. This agreement will be in effect for one year beginning June 1, 2009.

13. **MOTION** to approve a Memorandum of Understanding between Randolph Township Schools and Rutgers State University to continue to pilot the Sakai collaboration system. Rutgers has agreed to provide access to its installation of Sakai for a one year period for use by students and faculty at Randolph, beginning on July 1, 2009 and ending on June 30, 2010. Randolph agrees to pay Rutgers \$25,000 related to the terms of this agreement including hardware, software, and human resources. Randolph also agrees to pay Rutgers \$3,000 related to the terms of this agreement including human resources needed to conduct training. All travel expenses will be reimbursed by Randolph as accrued. Funds for this project will be charged to the No Child Left Behind Grant and the Technology budget.

14. **MOTION** to approve elementary teachers to write curriculum during the school day in the Language Arts area of Writing during May and June. Costs for substitutes will be paid by No Child Left Behind Grant.
