IDEA-B SERVICES **SCHOOL YEAR 2014 – 2015**

- A. Pursuant to official action taken at the meeting of the Board of Education of Randolph in the County of Morris held on 20th day of May 2014:
1. Said District agrees that the Board of Directors of the Essex Regional Educational Services Commission (ERESC) shall provide IDEA-B Services to classified student(s) attending nonpublic schools in the district of Randolph.
 2. The terms of the Agreement shall be in effect from July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.

Whereas, the Board of Education of Randolph has the authority to employ outside agencies to provide necessary and appropriate IDEA-B services for the classified students attending nonpublic schools in the DISTRICT; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

First: The ERESA, in consideration of the making of this Contract for the 2014-2015 school year, agrees to be paid hereunder by the District as the maximum and full compensation. ERESA shall provide services as needed during the 2014-2015 school year to classified students who are attending nonpublic schools in the District. The District shall provide the ERESA with the services to be provided after consultation with the nonpublic school administrators. The District shall provide the ERESA in writing with the proportionate share allocated for the nonpublic schools. If the District chooses to have the ERESA responsible to expend the carryover monies from the previous school year, the District must provide to the ERESA the amount of carryover in writing. The District after consultation with the nonpublic schools shall indicate in writing the services to be provided. A representative of the ERESA will be present at these consultation meetings whenever possible.

Second: The District shall remit payment to the ERESA after the above-mentioned services have been rendered. Payment is contingent upon proper execution by the ERESA of the District's vouchers and other documents which may be required for the proper fiscal management of the District.

Third: This Contract may be terminated by either party upon giving thirty (30) days written notice. In the event of termination, the ERESC shall be entitled to payment for services performed up to the date of the notice of termination.

Fourth: Costs for services are outlined as follows:

PT - Instructional Aide \$21.74-\$26.28 per hour (includes fringes and 6 % Admin. Fee) Based on educational background.

OT - \$90.00-\$140 per hour plus 6% Admin. Fee (Rate based on agency assigned)

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Counseling - \$55.00 per hour plus 6% Admin. Fee

Additional Supplementary Instruction Period - \$100.00/month (includes 6% Admin Fee)

Additional Speech Period - \$120.00 per month (includes 6% Admin. Fee)

Audiological Services-\$ 185.00 per hour plus 6% Admin Fee

Professional Development- Cost of Workshop plus 6% Admin. Fee

Supplies- Cost of Supplies plus 6 % Admin. Fee

Itinerant Teacher of the Deaf-\$110.00-\$175.00 + 6% Admin.Fee

Teacher of the Blind-\$1800.00 from September to June 2015 + 6% Admin.Fee

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Board of Education of Randolph in the County of Morris and the Board of Directors of the ERESA have, by resolution, directed that their respective presidents and secretaries must affix to this Agreement, a certified copy of the board resolution approving said Agreement.
