

0120 AUTHORITY AND POWERS

Authority

The Board of Education is constituted, authorized, and governed by the statutes of the State of New Jersey, Title 18A, Education.

Powers

The Board of Education shall make and amend rules that are consistent with statutes and repeal rules that are inconsistent with statutes of the State Board of Education; for its own government and the transaction of its business, for the government and management of the public schools and the public property of the school district and for the employment, regulation of, conduct, and discharge of its employees. The Board of Education shall perform all acts, consistent with law and the rules of the State Board of Education, necessary for the proper conduct, equipment and maintenance of the public schools of the district.
