

1522 SCHOOL-LEVEL PLANNING (M)

School Report Card

Annually, the school district shall disseminate a report card of each school, which shall contain statistical information specified by the Department of Education, to all staff and parents. The school district shall also make the report card available to the media.

School-level Plan

By September 30, each school in the school district shall develop and implement a two (2) year plan based on school report card data. This plan shall include student performance objectives, a review of progress by teaching and administrative staff and the involvement of parents.

At least once per semester, each school shall conduct meetings by grade level, Department, team or similarly appropriate group to review the school level plan. Such review shall include school report card data, Progress toward achieving student performance objectives and progress toward achieving core curriculum content standards.

Pupil Performance Objectives

The school planning team shall develop two or more objectives based on pupil performance or behavior standards. The objectives shall cover a period of not more than two (2) years.

If pupil performance is below minimum State standards, the planning team shall establish objectives to meet those standards. Benchmarks, or interim performance levels, shall be set to measure the school's progress toward the achievement of State minimum standards.

If pupil performance meets or exceeds minimum State standards, the planning team shall establish challenge objectives.

The Superintendent shall, no later than August 1 each year, submit each school's objectives to the County Superintendent for review and approval.
